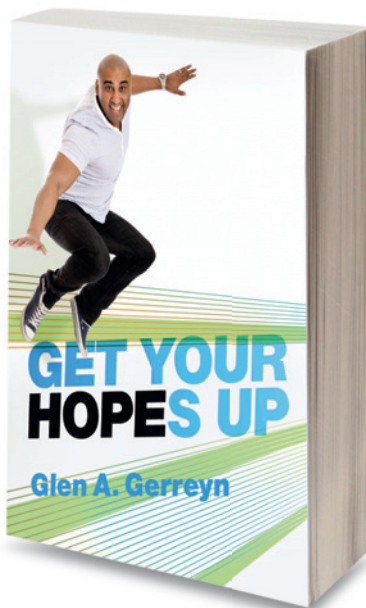

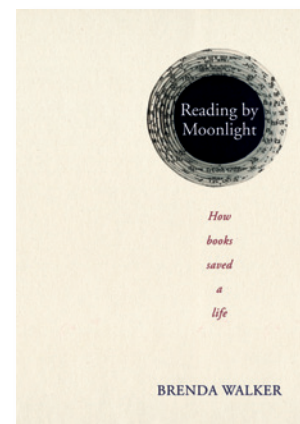


Get Your Hopes Up

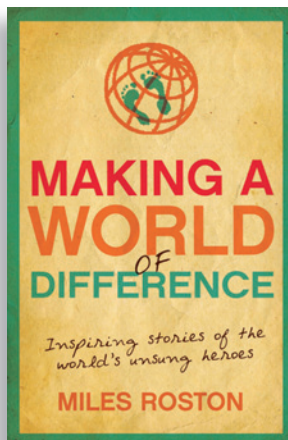
Reading by Moonlight
